

Railway

From Kansai International Airport Take the JR Kanku-kaisoku Line to JR Osaka Station. Walk for about 10 minutes to Hankyu Umeda Station, take Hankyu Takarazuka Line, and get off at Hotarugaike Station. Transfer to Hankyu Takarazuka Line at Hankyu Hotarugaike Station, and get off at Shibahara Station. Walk for around 8 minutes to Sigma Hall / Nambu Yoichiro Hall. From Osaka International Airport Take the Osaka Monorail and get off at Shibahara Station. Walk for around 8 minutes to Sigma Hall.

From Osaka, Umeda, and Shin-Osaka Take Hankyu Takarazuka Line at Umeda Station and get off at Hotarugaike Station. Transfer to Hankyu Takarazuka Line at Hankyu Hotarugaike Station, and get off at Shibahara Station. Walk for around 8 minutes to Sigma Hall.

Bus

From Kansai International Airport Take Airport Bus at No.8 stop which towards “Osaka Airport and Hotarugaike”, get off at Hotarugaike (terminal stop). Transfer to the Osaka Monorail and get off at Shibahara Station. Walk for around 8 minutes to Sigma Hall.
